LESSONS AND SCHEDULING:

Recognizing we live very busy lives, scheduling and re-scheduling well in advance is much appreciated and allows for the most flexibility. Lesson space is at a premium so lots of notice gives everybody the opportunity to ride.

NOTES:

My best recommendations for riding equipment are Mills Equestrian in Bellevue and The Gift Horse Saddlery in Woodinville. Knowledgeable staff and at both locations are very helpful. Mills tends to have somewhat lower prices for many items than the Gift Horse. Discount certificates are available for the Gift Horse that offer 15% off on your initial purchase of riding apparel, books, and equipment.



POLICIES:

The best and the most fun learning experiences happen when you are comfortable and relaxed. With this in mind, please follow these guidelines.

- **Dress for the weather.**
 - Layers work well, especially in colder weather, you will warm up as you ride.
- **Appropriate footwear is required.**
 - Low-heeled boots intended for riding are best (i.e. Paddock or cowboy boots). No large tread allowed (i.e. Hiking or running shoes). They pose a safety hazard as they can get caught in the stirrup.
- **A well-fitted riding helmet is required.**
 - Your safety comes first.
- **Gloves.**
 - Recommended, but not required. Gloves improve your feel and grip and are especially welcome in colder weather.
- **No loose or dangling jewelry.**
 - These can catch on riding equipment and cause serious injury. Also very loose or baggy clothing can be cumbersome as well as hazardous if it catches on equipment, gates, hooks, etc.
- **Cancellations.**
 - Please give at least one weeks notice if you know you are going to be gone (out of town etc.) This allows for greater efficiency and courtesy for everyone. Regular cancellation notice minimum 48 hours- emergencies are understood. Every effort will be made to find a mutually suitable makeup time.
- **Lateness – yours or mine.**
 - Please plan on showing up, even if you know you are going to be late, especially in situations such as bad traffic. We will try and make the best use of the time left. Please call to let me know where you are, that's why they invented cell phones! If my lateness causes you to miss your lesson, you will not be charged, and/or I will find a make up time for you.
- **Full / Half Training Lateness**
 - A training ride will be substituted on that day if notice allows enough time.



Riding Instruction Agreement and Liability Release

By this agreement, made and entered into this ____ day of _____, 20____, by and between _____, who resides at _____, hereinafter referred to as "I" and Jane Judson's Riding Lessons "Horses on Course", at 3219 W. Snoqualmie River Road NE, Carnation, WA 98014, hereinafter referred to as "This Stable."

IT IS HEREBY AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. That I, the undersigned, do for myself or on behalf of my child or legal ward, hereby voluntarily request that no participate in riding instruction as a student(s) at THIS STABLE, and that I will either ride my own horse, or one provided by THIS STABLE, that is deemed appropriate to my riding ability for instructional purposes.
2. That in the last two years student has ridden horses (write student's name or names beside appropriate riding time):
 - A. Less than 10 hours __ Student's name _____
 - B. 10 to 20 hours __ Student's name _____
 - C. 20 hours or more __ Student's name _____
3. That parent or guardian and student understand that horses and unpredictable by nature; that when frightened or angry or under stress, a horse's natural instincts are to jump forward or sideways, to run away from danger at a trot or gallop, to kick, to buck, to rear up in front, or to bite; that horses are extremely powerful; and that is a rider falls to the ground, the distance will be generally from 3-1/2 to 5-1/2 feet. I understand these risks, and I voluntarily assume these risks and dangers.
4. That parent or guardian and student understands that upon mounting the horse and taking up the reins the rider is in primary control of the horse, and that THIS STABLE is not responsible for the results of the student's actions or inactions. The rider further agrees not to abuse, misuse or deliberately agitate the horse as these actions may result in increased risk to myself and others.
5. That I have been advised that students should purchase and wear SEI approved helmet and to wear it in and around THIS STABLE as to prevent horse related injuries.
6. **LIABILITY RELEASE:** I understand that, except in the event of THIS STABLE'S wonton and willful negligence, I am responsible for bodily injury or property damage which I or my child or legal ward should sustain on THIS STABLE'S premises and/or trails and/or while riding a horse, and/or while in transit to or at horse shows, trail rides, or similar expeditions, and for any time I or my child or legal ward shall lose from



employment or school or other activity, and for medical expenses, or any other expenses incurred because of such bodily injury or property damage; and that I hereby, for myself, my heirs, administrators and assigns release and discharge the owners, operators, and sponsors of THIS STABLE and their respective servants, agents, officers and all other participants of and from all claims, demands, actions and causes of action for such injuries sustained to my person, or that of my child or legal charge and/or property.

7. That the student is currently covered by accident/medical insurance and will remain insured for the duration of all riding instruction at this stable.
8. That this agreement is entered into the state _____ and will be interpreted and enforced under the laws of that state.
9. Upon the signing of this agreement, student acknowledges that he/she has read and agrees to be bound to THIS STABLE'S rules attached and incorporated herein by this reference.

I, THE UNDERSIGNED, BEING OF LEGAL AGE AND OF SOUND MIND AND NOT BEING UNDER THE INFLUENCE OF ALCOHOL, DRUGS, OR INTOXICANTS, HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THE FOREGOING AGREEMENT AND RELEASE. I ALSO ACKNOWLEDGE RECEIPT OF A COPY OF THIS AGREEMENT THIS DATE.
